PARTNER AGENCY SPOTLIGHT THE COMMUNITY BUILDERS



It's no secret that prices are high on so many of the items that we buy every day. This is especially the case for big ticket items like furniture. Buying furniture can be out of reach for many of the clients of The Community Builders (TCB), a non-profit that develops and manages affordable housing for families, seniors, and people with disabilities. With the help of a federal HUD grant, TCB has partnered with CMHA and the City of Cleveland to build new housing for residents. Their community life department provides resident services. They help their residents, many of whom are single mothers, furnish their new homes through a partnership with the Cleveland Furniture Bank (CFB). The CFB is proud to be able to assist them through our Furniture for Families and Beds for Kids programs. Each referred family is given a voucher for furniture, including a new bed for each child in the family. At the CFB we are proud to support partners like the TCBs to serve others in our community.

Our 11th annual Inside the Park Home Run fundraiser underwritten by Minute Run Family of Companies was held on June 16 at Progressive Field. The event was attended by 781 men, women and children. It included a 4-mile run through the streets of downtown Cleveland, a 1-mile walk/run on the ramps of Progressive Field, and a Kids Dash around the warning track of the field. Everyone ended up just past home plate. The event raised over \$60,000 that will support our Beds for Kids and Furniture for Families programs. OHIO EPA GRANT

Earlier this year, we were awarded a \$100,000 grant from the Ohio EPA to purchase two new trucks needed to pick up and deliver furniture. This grant allowed us to upgrade our fleet of vehicles without increasing our expenses. Although the grant did not cover the entire cost of the two trucks, many of our supporters responded to a recent appeal and helped cover some of what the grant did not. This grant was a real blessing for our mission as were the supporters who contributed to us.
